<b>Course content</b>	- theoretical perspectives on mental health/disease and crises in different phases of life - various psychosocial perspectives on treatment and support initiatives for psychosocial disease - living conditions and changes in living conditions in connection with mental health/disease and the significance of gender, class and ethnicity - morbidity and recovery processes in a life course perspective - consequences of mental disease for networks, social relationships and working life
<b>Teaching</b>	Lectures, seminars and group work
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Bachelor's degree in social work or the equivalent
<b>Examination</b>	Individual take-home examination and seminar assignments reported verbally and in writing in Group.

<b>Limitations</b>	Students who did not avail themselves of or failed to pass in a regular examination opportunity are offered at least four additional opportunities to take the examination.
