Teaching The instruction occurs in the form of individual supervision. Choice of organism or natural

environment is made in consultation with the supervisor. The project plan must be approved by the supervisor or examiner before the inventory work begins.

Examination	Written and oral examination in the form of a written report and an oral report

Limitations	Students who did not avail themselves of or failed to pass in a regular examination opportunity are offered at least four additional opportunities to take the examination. One regular examination opportunity and two additional opportunities are offered in connection with the conduct of the course. Students who have failed to pass after these three examination opportunities will be referred for student counselling/support and given a new opportunity to take the examination during the next session of the course.
